Advanced Solutions:

As technologies continue to develop and advance, both in core technology and breadth of application, we will be reviewing the current state of the art in technology and applications

- Current advancements in technologies for passive, active and autonomous devices
- Future developments (eg. intelligent ICDs)
- Extending applications (eg. retrofitting ICDs)
- Branch & zonal control, downhole measurements
- Flow control devices for injector uniformity
- Field experience of applications

Improving Selection:

As continued drive to leverage maximum value from, and to prove the value that inflow control can bring, we will be reviewing the following areas:

- Designing the optimum placement and distribution of ICDs in the well
- Evaluate / quantify the effect of inflow control devices after installation
- Considering opportunity to retrofit inside current completions
- Managing risk associated with the introduction and application of new technology
- Case studies illustrating value generation and optimisation
